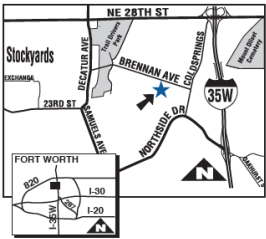

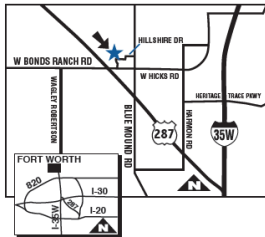

## Procedures

1. Fill out the Voucher Request Form available at [www.tarrantcounty.com](http://www.tarrantcounty.com) under Transportation or call Transportation Services to determine what type of voucher applies to you.
2. Purchase voucher from the County.
3. Wait to receive voucher by email, mail, or pick up in person
4. Take physical voucher and required ID with you to the Drop-Off Station with your recyclables.

## Voucher A

This voucher is priced at \$19.50 each and cannot exceed 10 cubic yards per drop-off (typically a 10-12' single axle trailer). Items can be working or non-working. These are the items that are included with a type A voucher:

- Brush and yard trimmings
- Recyclables such as clean and dry paper items, cardboard boxes, office paper, rinsed and empty plastic containers, glass, steel and aluminum containers and cans, etc.
- Small appliances and electronics such as microwaves, toasters, blenders, electric skillets, electronic toys, stereos, clock radios, tablets, iPods, etc.
- Large appliances such as washers/dryers
- Bulky/mixed trash such as broken furniture, vacuums, mops/brooms, framed mirrors, windows or doors, patio umbrellas, etc.



## Voucher B

This voucher is priced at \$32.50 each for material list under voucher A and special waste items combined but cannot exceed 10 cubic yards (typically a 10-12' single axle trailer). These are the items considered special waste and classified as a type B voucher:

- Residential building materials and household construction debris such as carpet, drywall, lumber, and insulation
- Tires (limited 4 per voucher)
- Freon containing items (limited 3 per voucher)
- Televisions and computer monitors/screens (limited 3 per voucher)

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*If you do not see specific items listed, please contact the Tarrant County Transportation Department to see if the item(s) will be acceptable.*

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## Things to Remember!

### Items not acceptable

Materials such as roofing shingles, rock concrete, asphalt, dirt, ceramic tiles, asbestos, PCBs, household chemical waste, radioactive items (oil field pipes and smoke detectors) and ammunition are not acceptable materials and are excluded from both vouchers

### Things to bring with you

**Be sure to have the physical voucher and a valid driver's license to the drop-off station. The facility's staff will need to keep the voucher at the check in station.**

### Types of vehicles

- **Dual axle trailers are not acceptable**
- All loads must be covered, secured and/or tarp materials to prevent loose debris from falling out and becoming litter or safety concerns during transit
- No vehicles or trailers can be labeled with commercial names or markings, except if renting a truck from U-Haul, Home Depot or Lowes for transporting materials
